Effective July 1, 2021, the Houston Solid Waste Management Department announced updated days and hours of operation for the Neighborhood Depository and Recycle Centers. As the City

continues to address trash and recycling pick-up delays, new hours of operation for the Depository and Recycle Centers will now be **Tuesday**



through Sunday from 9am – 7pm. All City Depository locations will be **CLOSED on Monday**.

Houstonians may use the depositories up to four times per month. Citizens are encouraged to arrive at least 30 minutes before closing. Each user must provide proof of residency with either a current Texas Drivers License or Texas ID <u>AND</u> a current utility bill or city property tax receipt that match the name on the drivers license. 
Residents are reminded to be a good neighbor when parking their vehicles around the neighborhood. Three of the most common received parking complaints heard in Shepherd Forest are:

BLOCKING OR PARKING ON A SIDEWALK – A vehicle cannot block the public sidewalk while parked in a driveway. Sidewalks must remain clear for pedestrian safety. Fines start at \$40.

PARKING VEHICLES THAT BLOCK PRIVATE DRIVEWAYS – A vehicle that is parked curbside may not block any portion of a driveway. Fines are \$40

PARKING ON THE STREET FOR MORE THAN 24 HOURS – Parking in the same space on the public street is limited to 24 hours – the vehicle must be moved after 24 hours. Fines start at \$30.


