WE HEAR YOU!

Shepherd Forest residents are the eyes and ears of the Shepherd Forest Civic Club. The Civic Club receives a number of calls and emails every week regarding neighborhood issues. These include crime, high weeds, abandonded vehicles, parking in yards, garbarge and debris, possible deed restriction

violations, new construction, architectural review questions, and much more.



Although it sometimes appears that "nothing has happened" to

your concern, the SFCC is working hard on every complaint and we will continue to give updates on the huge amount of work that is being done behind the scene on these issues. Covid has made the City's response time extremely slow to Neighborhood Protection issues including Deed Restricion violations, so some issues are taking more time.

SECURITY NEWS

Although several incidents of crime actually occurred in February in and around Shepherd Forest, records indicate the following were the only crimes in the area that were reported to HPD:

02/20 – 1500 block of WildeRock – burglary of residence 02/22 - 3100 Ella – Aggravated assault at Pollo Loco

(Shots were fired in this incident, but no one hit) 02/28 – 2400 block of Ansbury – burglary of residence

PLEASE REPORT ALL CRIME, REGARDLESS OF HOW INSIGNIFICANT IT MAY SEEM, TO HPD. It

could be something linked to another crime that you

have no idea about. It's been reported that there have been many suspicious people seen in the neighborhood recently,



so if you see something or someone that appears suspicious, PLEASE call HPD immediately. For life threatening emergencies or for crimes "in progress" please call 911, and for all other crimes call HPD at 713-884-3131.

Shepherd Forest is not immune from gang activity and recently the neighborhood entrance sign on Alba, as well as a stop sign on Attridge, had graffiti painted on them. If you see graffiti anywhere in or around Shepherd Forest, please immediately report it to 311 so that it can be removed. If possible, take a photo. Gangs use graffiti to "mark their territory" so let's work together to keep it out of Shepherd Forest!



All residents in Shepherd Forest are again reminded that they are bound by



the current Deed Restrictions for each Section of Shepherd Forest. Current Deed Restrictions require residents that are planning construction, remodeling, or major repairs to first submit their plans to the SFCC Architectural Committee for approval. Copies of Deed Restrictions are available at our website at www.ShepherdForest.org.

WHAT'S HAPPENING.

Many residents have noticed the massive removal of trees and clearing of land at the **south end of Oak Forest at Ansbury**. At the time of printing, the SFCC was not able to make contact or speak directly with the new owners or developers of the property, but had been told by others that plans were underway to build 70 townhomes on the property. Regardless of what is being built, Section 2 residents, especially those along Ansbury, will be affected by freeway noise, drainage/flooding issues, construction issues, traffic, and so much more.

We will continue to try to locate and make contact with the developers and keep SF residents informed of any information we learn or any action that is taken. Please contact the SFCC at 713-742-2470 if you have any information about this issue.


CLEAN UP DAY POSTPONED
