The SFCC Annual Salute to Veterans will be held on Monday, November 14th at 7pm at Garden Oaks Baptist





EARLY VOTING:

Early voting in Harris County begins on Monday, October 24th and runs through Friday, November 4th. You may vote at any Early Voting polling location in Harris County. Currently on weekdays and Saturdays, the early voting polls are open from 7am to 7pm, and on Sundays from noon to 7pm. Early Voting polling places near Shepherd Forest include: Sheraton Houston Brookhollow Hotel - 3000 North Loop 610 West (just west of TC Jester), 77092

ELECTION DAY VOTING:

MAIL-IN BALLOT INFORMATION:

The last day to apply for a mail-in ballot for those who qualify is October 28th. You can request a ballot by mail online www.harrisvotes.com or by calling the Harris County Clerk's Election Division 713-755-6965. If you do plan to vote by mail, please mail it back as soon as possible. You can now track your mail-in ballot at: **www.harrisvotes.com/tracking.**

HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS

- Trick or treat in familiar areas & only visit well lit houses.
- Carry a flashlight with fresh batteries after dark. Wear glow-in-the-dark costumes.
- Always trick or treat in groups. Small children should be accompanied by an adult.
- Stay on the sidewalks and out of the streets if possible. Cross only at intersections.
- Walk. No running. Watch for cars backing up or turning.
- Don't trample through flower beds and gardens and stay out of back yards
- Watch out for open flames in Jack-o-Lanterns. Wear fire retardant costumes
- Walk with your head up and be aware of your surroundings.
- Don't enter any houses unless you know the people that live there
- Don't eat any candy until it's inspected for tampering, especially if unwrapped/loosely wrapped
