

SECURITY REPORT

Security Coordinator Paul Berry reports that crime seems to be down a bit around Shepherd Forest. But don't let your guard down – stay alert to your surroundings and anything that looks suspicious. Paul encourages



everyone to report all crime (dial 911 for emergency or 713-884-3131 for non-emergency) to HPD, regardless of how insignificant it may seem at the time. After you make the call and report to HPD, Paul encourages everyone to also notify him at 915-373-8820 as to what has happened.

The number of calls and reports that are made to HPD directly impacts the number of patrol units that will be assigned to our neighborhood on a daily basis. This means that the more reports of crime in SF that we make, the more patrol cars that HPD will send our way. Make the call and report all crime!

Recent crime reported to HPD includes:

10/01 – 2100 blk of West 34th – Aggravated assault 10/05 – 3000 blk of Ella – theft of motor vehicle 10/17 – 2000 blk of West 34th – theft from motor vehicle 10/31 – 1700 blk of Stonecrest – trespassing


