Alert Shepherd Forest residents are the eyes and ears of the Shepherd Forest Civic Club. The Civic Club receives a number of calls and emails every week regarding neighborhood issues including crime, high weeds, abandonded vehicles, parking in yards, garbarge and debris, possible deed restriction violations, new construction, architectural review questions, and much more.

Although it sometimes appears that "nothing has happened" to your concern, the SFCC is working hard on every complaint and we will continue to give updates on the huge amount of work that is being done behind the scene on these issues. Often the City's response time is extremely slow to Neighborhood Protection complaints, so some issues take more time.
