HINES INTERESTS BRINGING A NEW LOOK TO 34TH STREET



While we are all enjoying the new commercial activity at the corner of 34th and Ella, residents in Section 1 can also look forward to something happening closer to them. Hines Interests, known for their upscale developments in the Galleria and Upper Kirby areas, plans to develop a 5-acre site at 1005 W. 34th. This will include +/- 380 units in two 4-story buildings and an adjacent 7-story multi-level garage with controlled access. According to Managing Director Chris O'Neill, the complex will be "highly amenitized", with a resort-style pool, fitness center, social lounges and leasing lobby. For those who are concerned about drainage issues, O'Neill assured residents that met with him before the variance hearing in February that they plan to build a stormwater detention system that exceeds the requirements set forth by Harris County Flood Control District. Groundbreaking is anticipated to be in the 4th quarter of 2019 or 1st quarter of 2020.

CITIZENS ON PATROL COORDINATOR NEEDED!

If you are a current member of the COP, you already qualify to serve as the Coordinator. Members must be over 18. have a valid TX driver's license, have passed the Police Department background check and have completed the brief training session with HPD.

Responsibilities of the Security Coordinator include:

- Attending the monthly Civic Club meetings
- Communicating with the COP members
- Maintaining a report/spreadsheet of all crimes reported
- Recruiting and organizing training for new patrollers

If you are NOT currently certified with the program, you can train alongside other candidates. Training takes place at the North Police Station (9455 W.
