
BE AWARE - THE TOP TEN LATEST SCAMS IN HOUSTON

Have you recently received a phone call, email, or piece of mail that said you have won a prize/lottery/sweepstakes? What about an offer of tech support for your computer or the guy that knocks on your door to tell you that you have a problem with your roof? Have you been hearing about some of the new "trial" offers, miracle cures, and counterfeit items being sold online? Or what about the official looking documents saying you need to pay for City related services? These are just a few of the many local scams that Houstonians fall for every day. Most of us think "it would never happen to me." But even the sharpest consumer can find themselves a target of a scam.

According to the Better Business Bureau, scam artists are skillful criminals, who successfully change their schemes on an ongoing basis to continue to steal money from their victims by using social media channels as a main way of targeting their victims, as well as mail, email, cold calls and internet pop-ups. Unfortunately, the number of people caught in scams like foreign lotteries and Internet scams are increasing every day. ANNUAL CHRISTMAS DINNER & PROGRAM A GREAT SUCCESS






