CITIZENS ON PATROL SECURITY REPORT

While several thefts and assaults within Shepherd Forest were reported to HPD last month, the major thoroughfares in and around our neighborhood continue to see a steady stream of crime occurring. As reported below, the area near Loop 610 and Ella, as well as along West 34th, seems to stay a "hot spot" for various crime. For reporting purposes, the 1900 block of North Loop 610 and the 3000 block of Ella Blvd is the area "generally located at the intersection of Loop 610 and Ella Blvd." Again, we advise our residents to be extra alert when in these areas.
