### WIRELESS EMERGENCY ALERT SYSTEM AVAILABLE

Emergencies don't care where you are – they can happen when you're at work, school, at home, or on vacation. The Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEA) system was developed to help inform the public in a specific area of emergency situations that require them to take action quickly to avoid injury, such as weather emergencies, terrorist activity, shelter-in-place orders, evacuations, & other emergencies which require action to protect life.



Your phone is likely already opted-in to receive WEA messages. If you've opted out, please make sure you opt-back in. These messages could save your life.

You never know how your information could be related to another crime or how the picture you just snapped could help solve a crime ring in the neighborhood. 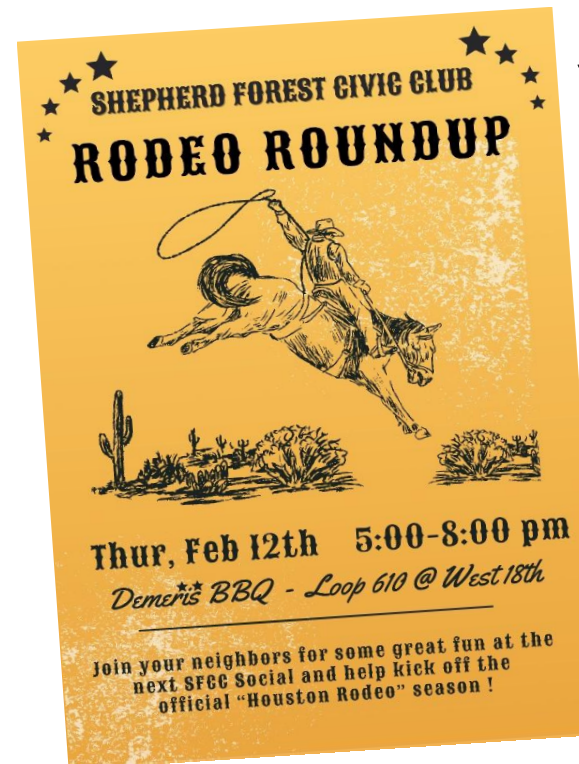

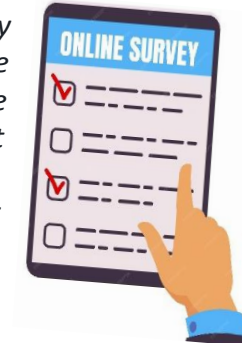

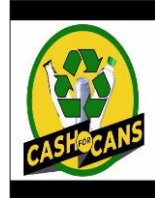
## ANNUAL EASTER EGG HUNT

Primary Elections for both political parties in Harris County will be held on **Tuesday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026**.

Voters are allowed to vote at **any** voting location across Harris County for Early Voting and on Election Day. Early voting for the Primaries will be held **from February 17<sup>th</sup> through Feb 27<sup>th</sup>** at multiple locations. Registered voters may cast ballots in either Texas' Republican or Democratic primary, but not both. Third-party candidates will appear on the ballot in November. The last day to register to vote in the Primary Election is Monday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>. **Don't miss this privilege!**

## Registering your Pet is the law.

The City of Houston Municipal Code (Section 6) requires that anyone who owns, keeps, possesses, or has control of a dog or cat four months of age or older must have his or her pet registered, vaccinated against rabies



every year, and a registered microchip. The City's pet registration identifies and protects your pet in case it becomes lost. (Even indoor pets can get out and become lost.) You are required to renew your registration yearly and update when you move and/or your pet is given away, lost, stolen or is deceased.

## REMODELING OR UPDATING YOUR HOME?

The Shepherd Forest Deed Restrictions require residents to submit all building and/or construction plans to the Shepherd Forest Civic Club Architectural Committee for approval **BEFORE** any work begins on their construction project.
